

Tomorrow at nightfall begins the Counting of the Omer in the Jewish tradition.

From April 6 to May 25, going through the Pesaj period, Easter until Shavuot.

Pesaj supposes the liberation of the soul against the slavery of the conditioning factors of the body.

This 7-week day-by-day computation entails 49 days of a mindfulness practice where "our" consciousness is placed on the seven sefirots of the Tree of Life that are found under the superior triad, and that suppose a deep internal purification and reordering of all the dynamics connected with these sefirot: Chesed, Geburah, Tiferet, Netzaj, Hod, Yesod until reaching Malchut, the kingdom of manifestation, our manifest world.

We can go much deeper into explanations but it is not my mission with this post to do so, but to explain that every day you will see a post with a reminder of the day's count (it starts counting every day at sunset). Under the post (On Facebook, Instagram. the Community of our YouTube channel, if you wish, you can comment on synchronicities that occur on the dynamics of the day or reflections. I am not an expert in it, only a small apprentice. A few years ago I also participated in a Omer's account, from the hand of a companion, Leslie.

Happy transit through the Omer Count, happy period of purification, awareness, spiritual elevation that takes us directly to the door of day 50, the door of Binah, in the upper triad, the world of Azilut.

The account of Omer comes from the promise of Moses that 49 days after the departure from Egypt, the people of Israel would receive the Torah.

Omer is also a measure of counting wheat. On the 50th day after the Omer, the annual wheat harvest began.

On the count of the Omer. the first week is dedicated to the sefira Hesed, the second to Guevurah, third Tiferet, fourth Netzaj, fifth Hod, sixth Yesod and seventh Malchut.

Practicing Jews who follow the law and the precepts follow a series of steps when counting the Omer. Other people, perhaps not Jewish but Kabbalists or similar, use this Account as a way of meditating and contemplating the values raised each day of the count.

The counting of the Omer begins with Hesed, the most absolute Love, Mercy and benevolence of the Source.

Every day in this post I will add an image with the account of the day and if inspiration arises, some reflection. Those of you who follow the Omer Account, if you wish to contribute with your perceptions, intuitions, experiences, you are welcome!!!

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DAY 49 on the Count of the Omer, Nightfall from May 24 to 25, 2023, Malkhut of Malkhut, the nobility in the Kingdom.

Counting the Omer MALKHUT OF MALKHUT NOBILITY IN THE KINGDOM DAY 49 IN THE OMER COUNT AST DAY BEFORE THE GATE 50 OPENS

Today we can contemplate the Nobility in the Kingdom of our

physical world, place of the manifestation of our creations. Nobility is not a noble title but a condition of the awakened and courageous heart because it dared to put its virtues before its defects for the greater good of itself and of others, not for personal glory but to glorify God, the Source.

Today we end the 49 days of semi-mourning that the counting of the Omer represents, a period between two sacred Jewish holidays (Pesaj and Savuot) that symbolize a time of purification and awareness that led the Jewish people from the liberation of Egypt to Mount Sinai to receive the tablets of the ten commandments.

The purpose of Counting the Omer is to activate our middot (virtues) in us and clean our vessels and their internal aspects in order to receive blessings when door 50 (Binah) opens, coinciding with the end of the Omer and the beginning of the festival of Shavuot.



DAY 48 On the Count of the Omer, Nightfall from May 23 to 24, 2023, Yesod de Malchut The foundation in the manifestation




Today we celebrate the penultimate day in the count of the

Today is a good day to contemplate the impact of our sexuality on our creations and that of our most primary bonds.



Today we can contemplate if we really communicate our

emotions in a creative way in our inner kingdom, in our fertile land in such a way that our creations manifested on solid ground can accommodate that expression of our authentic and true feeling. If we get frustrated and repress that feeling, our creations are marked by blocks, short circuits, broken dynamics that prevent our offerings from flowing. We oscillate between insecurity, fear of expressing ourselves, falsehood, conformism, seeking to please everyone knowing that it is impossible, excessive diplomacy that in the end breaks the pitch when the repressed energy of anger and despair arises, neither accepted nor accepted.

Happy day of exploration of our feelings. 


Today, holding hands with Archangel Michael, we can rise in

Today, we balance the forces of Giving and Receiving, characterized by the dynamics of the previous two days, through Tiferet, the solar force from the center of the Tree of Life In Malkuth, the Kingdom. We therefore bring beauty and balance to the physical world of manifestation, to our incarnation, our creations.



DAY 41 in Counting the Omer, Nightfall from May 16 to 17, 2023, Yesod in Yesod, sensitivity in relationships




Today we contemplate the power of Yesod squared, the lunar

DAY 40 in the Account of the Omer. Nightfall from May 15 to 16, 2023, Hod de Yesod, communication in bonds, relationships.




Today we can contemplate the power of structured language,

Those who connect the Omer with astrology will be able to


see that Netzaj in Yesod is related to Aquarius, so we could well be in this whole new age that is opening before us having to harmonize this aspect.

Day 38 in the Count of the Omer, nightfall from May 13 to 14, 2023, Tiferet of Yesod, the balance between Sun and Moon




Today we can contemplate the ability of the sefira Tiferet to




Today we can contemplate our sexuality and whether we

Masculine in Kabbalah is the giving principle, whether you are a man, a woman or however you define yourself, and feminine is the receiving principle. Whatever you are, there is a masculine/feminine principle in you.

Today we start a week going through the dynamics of the

Sefira of Yesod, representing the Moon, the reflection of our personality, the astral forces and personal connections. Day 35 in the Count of the Omer, Nightfall from May 10 to 11, 2023, Malkuth of Hod, manifesting the power of communication




Today we go down the Tree of Life to the world of

Day 34 in the Count of the Omer nightfall from May 9 to 10, 2023, Yesod de Hod, the foundation of sincerity in our expression




Today is a day in which we can contemplate the Alliance that


Today is a special day in the Counting of the Omer for two

Day 32 in the Count of the Omer, Nightfall from May 7 to 8, 2023, Netzaj of Hod, the emotional expression in language




Today we can contemplate the impact of our emotions, their

Day 31 in Counting the Omer, Nightfall from May 6 to 7, 2023, Tiferet of Hod, Harmony in structured language




Tiferet of Hod comes to balance the energies of the two

Day 30 on the Count of the Omer, evening from May 5 to 6, 2023, Gevura of Hod, strength in coherence




Today we can contemplate the rigor in humility, the severity




Today we can ask ourselves if our persistence is based on




Today we count 26 days in the Account of the Omer Hod in


Today we count day 23 in the Count of the Omer, Guevurah

DAY 21 on the Count of the Omer, Nightfall from April 26 to 27, 2023 Malkuth of Tiferet



Today we count Hod de Gevurá. humility in strength



DAY 11 in the account of the Omer, today we count Netzaj of Guevurah





DAY 9 on the Omer Count: Guevurah of Guevurah from April 14th at dusk to April 15th 2023




Today we count day 9 in the Count of the Omer, Guevurá de Guevurá at dusk from April 14 to April 15, 2023 wherever you are.

WEEK 2, DAY 8 on the Omer Count: Chesed of Guevurah: the goodness in limitation and restriction



Counting the Ome Yesod of Chesed The foundation, Our relationships





Today we count day 4 in the account of the Omer, Netzaj de Chesed.



DAY 3 OF THE OMER COUNT, from dusk April 7th to April 8th 2023 Tiferet of Chesed




Harmony and balance in love, kindness, mercy.

The rigor, the restriction, the limits in Love.


Today we can perceive that the energy of the day invites us to contemplate how we abuse the other and ourselves, for not setting limits to Love.

DAY 1 OF THE OMER COUNT, April 6th at dusk... CHESED OF CHESED

The counting of the Omer begins with Chesed, the most absolute Love, Mercy and benevolence of the Source.

Chesed of Chesed: Goodness in love, in mercy, in benevolence.

On this day we can meditate on love, on our ability to love others and ourselves, on the actions or omissions we do/don't do out of love for love, out of mercy in mercy. Questions that invite us to reflect on the sincerity of our love, how open we are to receive the love of the Source and to share it, with known people, strangers, with Life itself... Do we love Love?

Chesed is giving, this sefira is connected with the patriarch Abraham recognized for his hospitality, the ability to house the Divine Presence within himself.

Have mercy on our own Soul, the suffering it has when it sees us go astray or move away from our vital purpose...

Chesed is placed on the Tree of Life, in front of Geburah, Gevura, rigor, judgment. Chesed is located on the right side of the Tree of Life, considered the side of Mercy, the most expansive and giving side, where we also find Chochmah above Chesed and Netzaj below.

Chesed as mercy is one of the attributes of God. If we move away from Love, goodness and mercy, we move away from the Source and fall squarely into the world of rigor, judgment.

Psalm 86 says that God is slow to anger... and the Kabbalists teach us that this means that God gives us a margin of time so that the rigor resulting from our less beneficial actions does NOT end up falling with all its weight on us, but instead it allows us to rectify and transform our destiny through a change of consciousness. I remember reading a book years ago on the decoding of the Bible and what most caught my attention in that work is that a question was repeated throughout this ancient text... "Are you going to change it?"... In His goodness, the Source, gives us the opportunity to turn the tables, destiny... but we have to want it and walk in that direction. When we take one step towards the Source, He-She-It takes two steps towards us.

Actions that can help us this week and this day to activate Chesed, is Tsadaka, charity, meditation focused on God, ensuring not to fall into pride, anger, envy, evil speaking...

Jewish wisdom is interesting to say the least... it tells us how God operates and works from an angle that perhaps we had not contemplated, which opens and softens our hearts and thus allows us to better understand the Source.
